We survey members annually to prepare a priorities list for your consideration and support. Our intent is to identify areas that would benefit from campus attention. Issues identified by AMP in the past include the Campus Curriculum Leave and Planning Database, the Online Catalog and Course Approval system, and Staff HR hiring processes.

We are grateful for the efforts toward a comprehensive curriculum and leave planning database (Phase II) and online catalog and course approval system (Phase I) to reduce staff workload, improve accuracy, and decrease turnaround times. Phase I has been adopted; we look forward to Phase II being implemented.

AMP recognizes and applauds the efforts of Staff Human Resources for the improved turnaround times in making job offers. Establishing contact with candidates via email instead of a phone call has resulted in staff positions being filled much more quickly. Departments appreciate Steve Stein's leadership and collaboration.

One issue of concern not included in the priorities list is the 2027 sunset date for Oracle's support of AIS. This is likely to cause stalled development of important modules that leverage AIS.
